

March LifeCare Gets Thumbs Up From March Joint Powers Planning Commission

March HealthCare Development became one-step closer to final approval of the March LifeCare campus' Master Plot Plan and Specific Plan Amendment when March Joint Powers Authority planning commissioners unanimously recommended the final MPP-SPA documents at its July 6, 2011 hearing. The recommendation will be voted on for approval July 20th.

According to master developer Don Ecker, "with the submission of the MPP-SPA and the completion of our first phase of demolition, we are now ready to begin water and sewer infrastructure and selling land."

"We're proud of the team we assembled to complete the project. We've had the best and brightest minds working on this phase of the project including land use experts at Gresham Savage, the top regional engineering firm WEBB Associates, and internationally renown architects HOK," Ecker said after the hearing.

Also speaking at the hearing in support of the project were current partners: Riverside Medical Clinic Vice-Chairman Dr. Ravi Berry, Cal Baptist University Dean of Allied Health Dr. Chuck Sands, and Acorn Technology Corporation's CEO Don Dye. There were no opposition speakers.
