Scripps La Jolla Memorial Hospital Campus, Cardiovascular Institute
La Jolla, California

This project will combine the cardiovascular programs of Scripps La Jolla and Scripps Clinic/Scripps Green Hospital and will include 108 medical/surgical beds, 60 intensive care unit beds, 10 interventional/operating rooms, a new central energy plant, a sterile processing department and space for a future expansion of the emergency department; 330,000 sq. ft.
